1. How many babies (ie below the age of 1) were diagnosed with issues of ankylossia (tongue-tie) in 2013?
2. Of the babies diagnosed with issues of ankylossia (tongue-tie) in 2013, how many had a surgical procedure carried out by NHS surgeons to resolve these specific issues and how long did they wait (on average, in calendar days) for the procedure following diagnosis?
3. What was the mean age of babies with such issues when the ankylossia (tongue-tie) procedure was performed?
